TWC/ 2017/0162; 39 The Lloyds, Ironbridge; a site visit had disclosed that the solar tubes may be placed to face South. Clarification to be sought from Conservation officer re use of tubes (as opposed to panels). Guidance should also be sought on use of UpVC materials in World Heritage site. It was agreed that the council would Object to hot water tubes, ie as opposed to solar panels

Reports from communities:

 Cllr Bennett would like to set up discussions with TWC on Lightmoor issues and was encouraged to make direct contact

- b. Cllr Healy mentioned blocked path at side of Woodside House. Clerk to ask roadmen to clear and remove ivy.
- c. The walls and railings next to Coalbrookdale YHA are in need of repair. Clerk to report this to Conservation Officer
- d. Dale End Park; it was noted that some equipment was still needed. Ongoing
- e. Cllr Healy queried if it were time to put together a calendar of traditional community events
- f. Cllr White would be chasing up question of lighting at Lightmoor
- g. Cllr Hobson mentioned that drains in Coalport still blocked. Clerk to chase TWC He also mentioned:
 - trees in Riverside Avenue need attention
 - Cllr Hobson had received a letter from Coalport resident about speed of builders traffic; he has spoken to the site office. However, there is no money for SIDs and residents should be encouraged to report speeding to the police
 - Letter from Coalport resident re fencing next to Brewery Cottage was noted, but she should be encouraged to report this to David Jones, Planning Enforcement Officer

h. Cllr Bragg mentioned:

- gullies at end of Church Road are full of weeds . Clerk to remind TWC of need to clear road gullies , especially in Coalbrookdale
- Land at White Horse pub and permission to develop site. David Jones to monitor it
- There have been complaints about "The Crown" at Hodge Bower. Agreed that this was not a Parish Council matter and anyone concerned should contact TWC

It was noted that the Annual Parish Meeting would be held at Coalbrookdale Community Hall on Thursday 4th May; Chair to ask if a member of the Traffic team could talk on SIDs and traffic enforcement.
