Further to Gareth's email, our view is if the Parish, IBC and Ward Member want the cushions back, and that can be agreed, we can arrange for these to be installed. At this time we do not have the capacity to arrange a consultation on this, however should the Parish (or other local body such as the IBC or Ward Member) wish to do so, and come back to us with a decision we can then arrange the installation of cushions.

The difficulty with the consultation and the cushions will be if there is any chance of a consensus, which from my experience is very difficult to reach with regard to raised calming features. Recent consultation on this kind of thing have reached 50/50 support, potentially then requiring a local decision on which way to go.

I appreciate that may not be the response you hoped for, but we will support in the installation if that is the local desire.
